
SAFETY NET SERVICES Emergency Shelter



GOAL: COMMUNITY MEMBERS HAVE ACCESS TO SHELTER.

35% of Wood County and 44% of Adams County households are struggling – despite most of these households earning income above the Federal Poverty Level. Working, yet unable to afford all essentials or save for emergencies, we term these households <u>ALICE: Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed.</u>



invested in partner programs in 2024. Calls were answered by our local 211 contact center regarding housing and emergency shelter in 2023. Individuals participated in the South Wood County Homelessness Roundtable in 2023. Individuals with disabilities received assistance from partner programs to obtain & sustain independent housing in 2023.

volunteers participated in the Homeless Point in Time Count in January 2024.
