SUCCESS STORY: Billie, who is grandma to a 4 year old attending a local child care center completed an application to get help with their past due bill. Billie and her husband take care of their granddaughter. When Billie's mother was diagnosed with COVID and nearly lost her life, Billie needed to take off work to care for her, which caused them to fall behind on their child care tuition. They needed help with this past due bill otherwise their granddaughter would not be able to continue going to care. Childcaring was able to send payment directly to the child care program to make their balance current.
