ASSOCIATION OF ALL HANDICAP CITIZENS provides socialization opportunities for adult members of the community with special needs. Volunteers for the group help support and sponsor monthly dances, fishing experiences, field trips to the ballpark and bowling alley or social visits. "Mary" attends the dances regularly. Each time she arrives, she greets each volunteer with a big hug, feeling as if they're all one big "family." "John" also likes to attend the dances. He specifically asked if one of the volunteers, "the tall girl that always gives me extra popcorn" would visit him at his resident facility. The volunteer was overwhelmed with emotion that this man she had recently met through the Association would be so excited by the opportunity for a personal visit.
